

2017 STEEP SLOPE LOGGING CONFERENCE FIELD TOUR

The 2017 Steep Slope Logging Field Tour will be taking delegates from Kelso down to Prescott then along the Kalama River deep into the forest.

When delegates alight from the transport, they will be able to view a number of machines at work. The machines on site are planned to include: a buncher working un-tethered on flat ground, a shovel loader as a static display, a working John Deere Tractionline system, and an anchor machine with a mechanical feller from Summit Equipment.

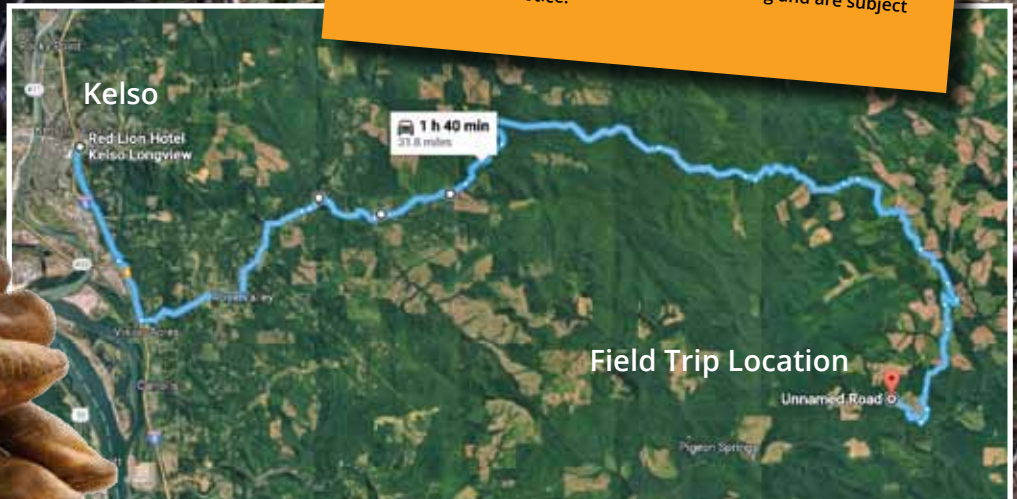
A short walk further, and delegates will be able to view two tethered machines working an uphill slope and also be able to view a tethered machine working a downhill slope.
